<b>Afternoon Assessment Session</b>	
<b>1.30</b>	We aim to support at least 20 candidates through an assessment process. Each will have opportunity to judge, place and critique five dogs. Each of the dogs will have been previously assessed by 3 assessors to gain an opinion of possible placement in a show ring setting.  These assessors will be available on the day to oversee the event and to discuss placement of the dogs if required. Our assessors are recognised breed experts and currently give Challenge Certificates in the Breed. Delegates will get an information pack closer to the date to explain the process further.
